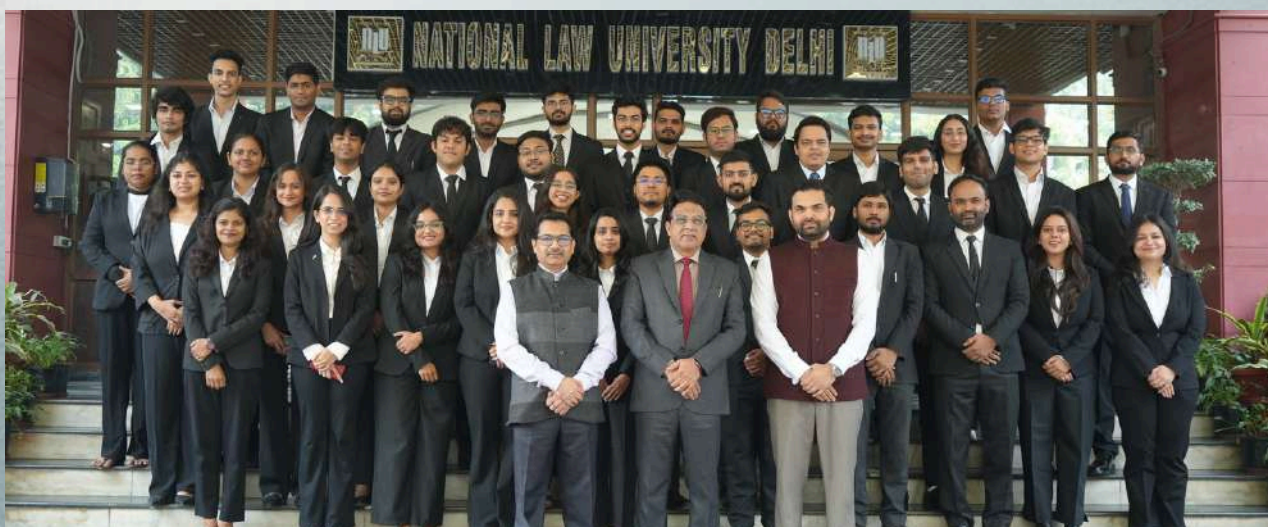
POST-GRADUATE INSOLVENCY PROGRAM

Launched in partnership with the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI), the PGIP is meticulously designed to create a new cadre of qualified insolvency professionals who can navigate the complex landscape of corporate distress with legal precision and commercial acumen.

ELIGIBILITY



Eligibility For Admission

All candidates should appear for the All India Entrance Test (AIET), and selection shall be solely on that basis.



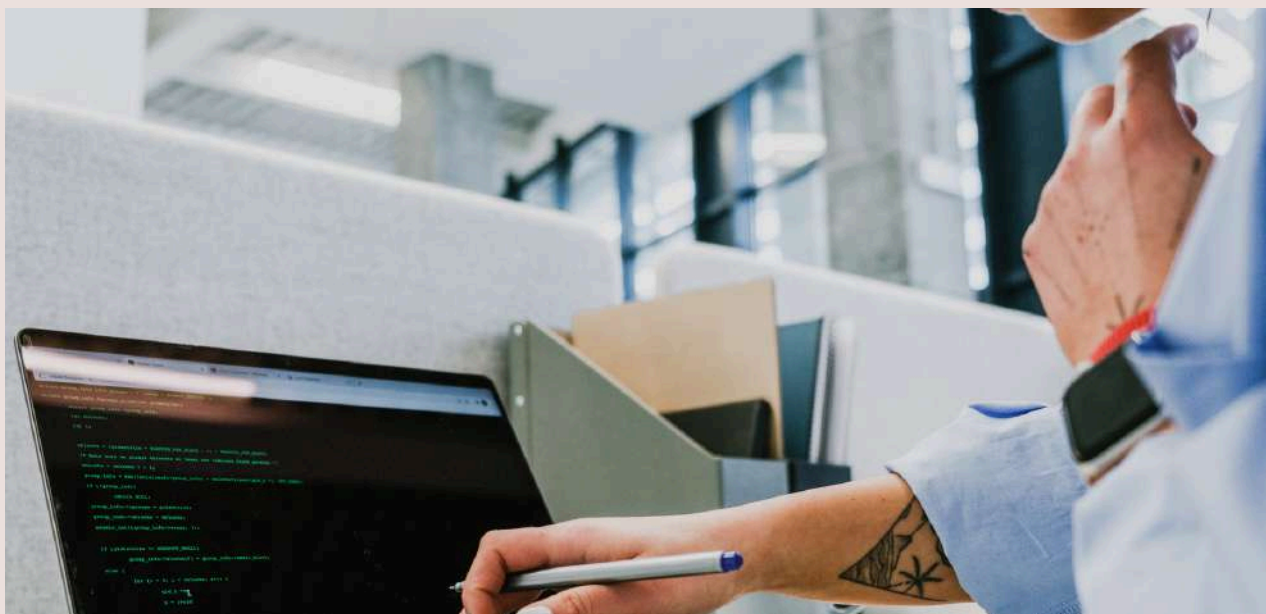
Prior qualifications needed

The eligibility criteria should be clearly split between educational qualifications and age requirements to ensure applicants understand which degree they will receive upon completion.



Eligibility extends to candidates

Eligibility extends to candidates who have completed professional or academic qualifications such as Company Secretary, Chartered Accountancy, Cost Accountancy, Law, Engineering, Technology, Economics, Finance, Commerce, Management, or Insolvency, with a minimum of 50% marks.



POST-COMPLETION BENEFIT

According to the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Insolvency Professionals) Regulations of 2016 (amended up to 18-09-2023), under Chapter III, Regulation 5:

Subject to the other provisions of these regulations, an individual shall be eligible for registration if he has completed the [Post] Graduate Insolvency Program, as may be approved by the Board;

Upon completing the 2-year Postgraduate Insolvency Program (PGIP) Master of Arts (MA) / Master of Laws (LLM) Degree in Insolvency programme and passing the Limited Insolvency Examination, candidates will become eligible for registration as Insolvency Professionals without the need to accumulate the previously required 10 years of professional experience.
